How Can I Learn About Asthma From the Internet?

- Information from the internet **should not** replace medical care.
- The Internet can connect you with information around the world.
- Asthma information can be found at different addresses (websites) on the Internet.
- If you do not own a computer, public Internet access can be found at community sites such as the local library or Community Centre. Ask about sites in your community.

Is It Good Information?

- Anyone can put anything on the Internet. **Some information may not be correct.**
- Do not trust a site that says they can cure asthma. At present, there is no cure for asthma.
- Look for well known organizations. See the websites suggested on this website.

Question What You Read

- Who wrote the information? Do they work with known organizations? (eg. hospital or universities).
 - Is it easy to read and understand?
 - Does it seem complete? Can it be checked with other trusted sites?
 - Is the information recent and up to date? Do links to other sites still work?
- Other people may share their experiences on a website. Be careful about following their advice.
